Chairman Hubert heard shots when he was exiting his building. Security is an important issues for our employees and will be reviewed to seek improvements.
- We received an outstanding letter of salutation from Ms. Karen Stanforth, commending the work of Columbus Investigator, Richard Garcia.
- Darlene Newbern provided a review of civil rights laws to the EEO Committee for the Ohio Contractor's Association in Columbus on March 1, 2012. Her presentation was well received.


